- Medically necessary doctor's services
- Outpatient care
- Home health services
- Durable medical equipment
- Mental health services
- Preventive services including but not limited to:
  - Annual Wellness Visits
  - Alcohol misuse screenings & counseling
  - Cervical & vaginal cancer screenings
  - Chronic care management services
  - Colorectal cancer screenings
  - Counseling to prevent tobacco use & tobacco-caused disease
  - Depression screening
  - Diabetes screenings & prevention
  - Flu shots
  - Mammograms
  - Mental health care (outpatient)
  - Rural health clinic services

- **Dentures**
- **Long-term care**
- **Cosmetic surgery**
- **Massage therapy**
- **Routine physical exams**
- **Hearing aids and exams for fitting them**
- **Concierge care**
- **Covered items or services you get from an opt-out doctor or other provider (except in the case of an emergency or urgent need)**
